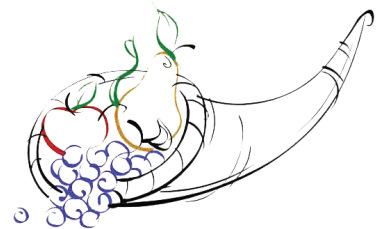

France NV

Veneto, Italy NV

An elegant and intense bouquet, dry, soft and rounded. With fresh peach and red berry flavours on the palate.

3. **Canard-Duchêne Brut** £29.95
Champagne, France NV

A fabulous and well-respected Champagne. Clean and fruity in style, with baked-bread and bruised-apple notes, fresh and easy drinking. It started out as a favourite amongst the Tzar's cavalry, who would pop the bottles with their swords. The logo shows the story.

Champagne, France NV

5. Cuvée de Richard Blanc £3.75 £5.00 £9.55 £17.95 £13.95
PGI Pays d'Oc, France 2010/11

A dry yet creamy white wine with clean, fresh fruit on the palate and a zesty finish.

6. Nandu Sauvignon Blanc £4.25 £5.75 £15.95
Central Valley, Chile 2010

Youthful and lively medium dry wine. With herbal tropical notes on the nose, followed by a citrus palate.

7. Tin Roof Chardonnay £17.95
South Eastern, Australia 2010/11

A soft, buttery Chardonnay, with a smooth mouthfeel and a rich fruity finish.

8. Paul Mas Estate Marsanne £17.95
PGI Pays d'Oc, France 2010/11

A well-balanced white, from delicate to full flavoured with elegant pear, white flower and hazelnut aromas.

9. Malandrino Pinot Grigio £17.95
Veneto, Italy 2010

Made using 100% Pinot Grigio, this wine displays notes of citrus fruits, with a hint of floral aromas.

10. Rueda Blanco, Marqués de Riscal £18.95
Rueda, Spain 2010

A light, delicate white wine with an intensely aromatic bouquet bursting with fruit.

11. La Baume Viognier £19.95
PGI Pays d'Oc, France 2010

This popular wine is medium bodied, with powerful aromas and a hint of apricot and spice. Finished with a dash of Viognier's trademark body & ripe citrus notes.

12. King's Favour Sauvignon Blanc £20.95
Marlborough, New Zealand 2010

A superb Sauvignon Blanc from the creator of the famous Cloudy Bay. A wine of balance and elegance with hints of lime, grapefruit zest and lovely strong minerals to match.

13. Cave de Turckheim Riesling £22.95
Alsace, France 2009

Refreshing and light, hailing from its' homeland in the Alsace region by one of the oldest producers. Green fruits and citrus splashed around the palate.

14. Chablis Jacques Decharmes £27.95
Chablis, France 2009

Lively citrus flavours including grapefruit and orange peel with a light honey and spice finish, reminiscent of ginger and beautifully balanced.

15. Pouilly-Fumé Tryptique £32.95
Pouilly-Fumé, France 2009

Immensely pure and detailed on the nose and palate with stony, crushed oyster shell fruit aromatics which are gently supported by a cushion of the finest oak. The limited crop yields & production makes this wine a real treat.

16. Cuvée de Richard Rouge £3.75 £5.00 £9.55 £17.95 £13.95
PGI Pays d'Oc, France 2009/10

Silky smooth with dense, ripe blackberry and plum fruit, leading to a rounded finish.

17. Robertson Winery Cabernet Sauvignon £4.25 £5.75 £15.95
Robertson Valley, South Africa 2010/11

A gently full bodied red wine enhanced by rich mulberry, plum and cassis fruits and subtle soft tannins.

18. La Croisade Réserve Merlot £17.95
PGI Pays d'Oc, France 2009/10

Showing a lively bouquet of plum, blueberry and hints of blackcurrant on the nose, the palate is beautifully rounded, soft and juicy.

19. Rioja Los Bailadores £18.50
Rioja, Spain 2010

Violet in colour and soft and fruity in style. Warm, plummy aromas tinged with subtle spice and vanilla.

20. Otterbrook Mill Shiraz £18.95
South Eastern, Australia 2009

Complex, elegant and pure. Smooth palate showing notes of plum & dark berry fruits, all supported by a touch of toasty oak.

21. Baron de Baussac Carignan £18.95
PGI Pays de L'Herault, France 2009/10

An indigenous grape variety of the Languedoc, Carignan produces this trendy wine with plenty of body. Deep and inky red in colour, the wine is crammed with black cherry fruit.

22. Château Savariaud Bordeaux £19.50
Bordeaux, France 2009

This classic Bordeaux has lots of black berries, hints of cedar and a rich, ripe finish.

23. Beyerskloof Pinotage £19.95
Stellenbosch, South Africa 2009

This well known producer exhibits all the ripeness of the Cape's best wines with a lovely long smokey finish.

24. Fleurie Flower Label, Georges Duboeuf £22.95
Beaujolais, France 2009

One of the finest smooth red wines which is still packed with fresh cherry fruits and a fragrant, floral perfume with an attractive silky texture.

13B. Chianti Villa Dante £23.50
Chianti, Italy 2007

An intense, ruby coloured Chianti showing classic aromas of cherries, wild berries and hints of vanilla, which follow through to the palate.

14B. Château Grevière Médoc £27.95

Médoc, France 2002

This is a simply delightful classic Medoc that exudes cedar aromas and ripe black fruit flavours. Drinking fantastically well with perfect balance and age.

15B. Châteauneuf-du-Pape 'Cuvée des Antiques' £32.95

Châteauneuf-du-Pape, France 2009

Seductive aromas of spice and mature fruit, and the most rounded, generous palate lifted by the warmth of a good vintage.
